One of the things you can always count on in non-profit work is change. And we've experienced plenty of change in 2016. New funders and growth, new partnerships for greater community impact. We're in a very exciting place with our Foster Grandparent Program. Thanks to new support from the Juvenile Welfare Board, we've been able to grow our program in a way we never have before.
